SCU has invested more than \$10 Million in initiatives to improve the academic achievements of our students as well as our projects to develop educational content, raising the quality of lectures. Students have access to excellent academic services at our offline campuses, which are equipped with the latest amenities and recognized as being among the best academic facilities in Korea.

Korea's Largest e-Learning Studio with Automated Capture System

We opened the e-Learning Studio on April 9, 2012. With 560m² in floor space, the largest facility of its kind in Korea. More importantly, the state-of-the-art capture system automates the recording and editing processes to produce lectures in full-HD resolution. This system has more than tripled the productivity of producing educational materials in video and other media formats, allowing the staff to devote themselves to planning more creative educational materials.

Faculty of World-renowned Scholars

The faculty at Seoul Cyber University includes distinguished scholars who graduated from Harvard and other prestigious universities. One full-time professor is assigned to every 200 students, bringing the ratio of full-time professors and students to the highest level in Korea. In addition, the latest lecture methods, which utilize multimedia materials, deliver great student satisfaction and help build effective communications between professors and students.

SCU Learning WAVE: World's Top-class e-Learning System

SCU Learning WAVE, an acronym for Why, Action, Value and Expansion, is the only e-learning system developed in-house by Korean online colleges. It integrates "dynamism" into the system, a unique way to deliver content beyond the traditional methods. Seoul Cyber University invested two years in planning and developing the SCU Learning WAVE system, which includes three sub-systems and two proprietary content-creating tools. We are the first Korean online educator to adopt the Common Cartridge format, a set of specifications developed as an international standard for exchanging college learning content.

Seoul Cyber University leads educational practices in Korea. We are participating in the ASEAN Cyber University project in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, and our integrated mobile system allows students to access administration services conveniently via smart phone.

ASEAN Cyber University Project

Seoul Cyber University was nominated as the implementing partner in Korea for the ASEAN Cyber University project, an official development assistance initiative in the area of education. The project is supervised by the e-Learning Department of the Ministry of Education. We have been engaged in this project since 2012. The goal is to establish the world's first international higher education institution where the peoples of Korea and the ten ASEAN member-states can attend lectures, earn credits and receive degrees online. Seoul Cyber University is assigned to facilitate credit transfer, develop a high quality of educational content, and to create a collaborative framework for academic exchange.



Integrated Mobile Service

Our Integrated Mobile Service system provides a mobile application and relevant web pages, which were developed in-house, allowing users to access the system by smart phone regardless of their mobile service providers. The system features lecture samples and admission information, improving student accessibility and convenience. The mobile server is synchronized with the integrated information system to allow users to retrieve information on lectures, attendance, and GPAs.

Offline Education

SCU campuses are located in Seoul, Indeogwon, Chuncheon, Incheon, Bundang, Yeonmudae, Daegu, Gwangju and Busan. They provide venues for various offline gatherings such as special lectures, seminars, and club activities. Students enjoy their campus life beyond the expectation for ordinary online universities.

"Gathering Day" Events at Local Campuses

Gathering Day has been held once a month at a campus other than the main Seoul campus since 2010 as a part of an overall initiative to foster activities at the provincial campuses. The plan was designed to ensure that the provincial campuses are a place where students want to be and where the necessary services are available. On Meeting Day, SCU's professors give special lectures on a selected theme relating to study as well as counseling services for learning.

Overseas History and Culture field Trip

SCU has promoted various programs for visiting foreign countries with the aim of fostering talented people who are internationally competent with a global perspective, extensive experience, and a progressive attitude. Every year, our students go to governments, enterprises, universities, research institutes, and social organizations that boast world-class expertise and systems. The "SCU Love of Gangwon-Yeongdong" Club was established in 2005 to let students and graduates who had already become involved in society share important information related to volunteer work or employment, as well as to develop and improve themselves. The gathering started for those living in Gangwon province. Many people, however, were attracted to the warmth of the volunteer work, so it expanded to also include the Yeongdong region. Currently, approximately 140 students participate in the club and do volunteer work under the name of "Seoul Cyber University - Love of Gangwon Yeongdong Voluntary Work Team" in cooperation with local social organizations. In response, the Department of Military & Police Counseling offers courses on special counseling programs targeting the problems and issues unique to these institutions, and general psychological counseling programs related to human relationships and organizational management. Upon the completion of the designated courses, students are eligible for various counseling certificates, including those for military counselor, police counselor, youth worker, youth counselor, social worker, and psychological counselor.

International Trade & Logistics

Experts in International Trade and Logistics Commanding Global Leadership

The paradigm-shifting trends of globalization, online conversion and convergence are now challenging the conventional concepts of trade and logistics. Responding to these trends, the Department of Trade and Logistics developed a comprehensive curriculum integrating the three key study areas (trade practice, international business, and logistics management) to create a unique course in Korea.
